





Expofest Jingle Blast Worlds Bid Declaration:

Up to one (1) Partial Paid and two (2) At Large bids will be awarded during Expofest Jingle Blast. The value of the partial paid bid will be determined by the number of teams competing for a Worlds Bid at the event:

Eight (8) or fewer teams: \$3000 USD

Between nine and fourteen (9-14) teams: \$4000 USD

Fifteen (15) or more teams: \$5000 USD

To be eligible for Worlds bid divisions a program must: Attend the bid championship event with a minimum of (3) Non-Worlds teams per (1) Worlds team, for a total of (4) teams. Programs without (4) teams total must register 100% of their competitive program. Programs competing for Worlds bids must adhere to IASF rules and safeguarding requirements.

Bids will be offered for all IASF Worlds divisions including non-tumbling routines. Partial Paid bids are not reserved for any particular division.

Please note: Bids will be awarded based on final scores for the weekend and at the judges' discretion. Bid will **NOT** be awarded solely by score since the comparison between divisions is not equal. Consideration will be given to teams who do well at Expofest and whom the judges feel will be most successful at Worlds in their divisions.

Tie Breaking:

Since Expofest does not give bids based on scores, a tie breaker specific to worlds bids is not necessary. However, we do have a tie breaker policy for all divisions as outlined below:

Tie Breaking Steps (in Priority Order)

- 1. Team with least total deductions will be placed above the other team(s)
- 2. Team with least legality deductions will be placed above the other team(s)
- 3. Team with the highest unweighted total "Overall Routine Impression & Showmanship" will be placed above the other team(s)
- Team with highest difficulty scores will be placed above the other team(s)
- 5. Judges will be polled. Majority Rules. All judging decisions are final.
